

Our ongoing Projects

1. HOPE SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR MENTALLY CHALLENGED CHILDREN

There are 65 Children enrolled in the school from very weaker section of the community. They all receive free special education, health care and vocational training on Handicraft products making.



2. EARLY INTERVENTION CENTER FOR INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY.

Our main activity to identify children at an earlier time of child birth and the problem of related to Disability. We provide speech therapy, physiotherapy, teach and train children in the normal system of Daily activity. At present about 60 children admitted in the centre at the age group of 0-6years. Children are involved in social interaction and communication to up-grade their Intellectual skill



3. HOPE SHELTER HOME FOR ABANDONED MENTALLY RETARDED CHILDREN

Currently there are 55 children and adult admitted in the Home, All those left from their parent without conscious, picked by the police on nuisance case and Admitted in the centre for CARE & PROTECTION. They receive full time rehabilitation services as such Basic education, medical services and skills training.



4. MAHLA (Mother Access to Health Lively hood & Advocacy)

This project supports the mothers of the children exists with Intellect Disability, to promote them towards comprehensive health, education and socio-economical standard. There are 30 mothers as full time beneficiary by this project, receive Income Generation trainings. Tailoring, Embroidery, beautician course and Jewellery making and marketing.



5. SPECIAL TEACHING & TRAINING CENTRE FOR AUTISM CHILDREN.

On 18th July' 2019, Mrs. Maheswari Ravikumar, IAS, District Collector-Thiruvallur Inaugurated this Centre at Arignar Anna Boys Higher Secondary School, Poonamallee Block.



Through this centre we are providing special teaching and training to the children existing with Autism. About 20 Children at the age Group of 2, 3years to 6years admitted in the centre for speech therapy, physiotherapy, social and Intellectual training. This training center is run by the latest teaching technology as an innovative methodology as such learning through Kids play, singing, dancing, and uses of i-Pad and so on.

6.COVID-19 COMMUNITY INTERVENTION PROGRAM ZONE - 7 UPHC - KORATTUR

As keeping the good services of Hope Trust, The Greater Chennai Corporation allotted work plan on COVID-19 Community Intervention Program around 25,000 Slum population coverage.

Currently our Out Reach Worker, Supervisor and volunteers around 30 members are rendering services for the above project.

- To provide health education on prevention and control of COVID-19 survey of slums, treatment, health care services find out people in the early signs and symptoms of COVID-19 referral to nearest hospital and health camps.
- To meet the other essential requirements.



UPCOMING PROJECT

Hope Residential Home & Vocational Training Centre

There are many children left without any support and due to restricted accommodation in our Care and Protection Centre not able to admit more than 55 children. The demand for such children care is very much required. Due consideration and demand for service, considered and planned for construction of own building. We purchased and registered 4 grounds of CMDA approved land at Annambedu village, Pattabiram, Survey No:19/2015. We planned to construct a building at 2 grounds (Ground floor + 1st Floor at 9604sqft estimated cost of about **Rs.1,80,00,000 Rupees 1crore and Eighty Lakhs.**)for establishing fulltime Residential home and Vocational Training Centre to accommodate more children and Special Training on organic farming setup.

on **26th January 2020 Republic Day** we did **Bhoomi Pooja** and from February we started the construction work, Borewell, EB Connection and Foundation work initiated. Due to fund constrains and COVID-19 lockdown work is been delayed. We have approached the state Bank for loan process for the Building construction.
