STATE ADVISORY BOARD OF DISABILITY MEETING ON 16.10.2023 @ SECRETARIAT, CHENNAI

The Tamil Nadu State Advisory Board on Disability Welfare meeting was held on October 16, 2023 at the Tamil Nadu secretariat, Namakkal Kavingner Maligai. Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Thiru M. K. Stalin, and the chairperson of the board presided over the meeting. All the officers from Differently Abled Welfare and the special director and the nominated advisory board members participated in the meeting. Dr. V. Nagarani, Founder/ Managing Trustee, presented a certain valuable agenda in the meeting:

- For children with cerebral palsy, the Differently Abled Welfare Department provide splint supportive aid every year, but every year it could be modified, and supply can be recommended depending on the conditions of the child.
- Every 10 years, a scooter is provided to Differently Abled either to be made full service orto replace the new scooter. 10 years will be a period of fitness.
- In every district hospital, a doctor will be posted full-time to provide medical services for children with an intellectual disability.
- For every care and protection shelter, homes must be initiated and vocational skills extended development activities.
- Parents of the Differently Abled are struggling to take over a rented house in Chennai. The state, the government can allot houses to the slum clearance board, or the Tamil Nadu Housing Board on free of charge, particularly on the ground floor.
- Information on web sites and advertisement of early intervention centers, autism special training centers, special schools for children with intellectual disabilities and care and protection centers for I.D children and rehabilitation homes for people with mental illness. All activities and the operational systems are to be televised on TV as special awareness for the public domain.





PEOPLE WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES (3rd December 2023)

On December 3, 2023, World Disability Day, a special award event for people with developmental disabilities was held at Kalaivanar Arangam. Master. Jayachandran, a student at Hope Special School, won first place in the Spastic event at the state level. Our Honourable Chief Minister, MK Stalin, expressed his appreciation and honoured Master. Jayachandran. Also, district-level competition was held for special needs children, where children from various districts of Tamil Nadu participated, and it's such a joy that our Thiruvallur District stood second in the State Level at overall sports and Cultural championship.

Hope Public Charitable Trust, Chennai, celebrated Republic Day at its Vocational Training Centre, Annambedu Village, Poonamallee Block. There was also a special presence from Teleperformance Global Service Limited. Dr. V. Nagarani, Founder and Managing Trustee, welcomed the attendees and spoke about the project activities in Chennai and Thiruvallur District that are supported by Teleperformance, Maersk, and Well-Wisher. About 267 children with intellectual disabilities are the beneficiaries of the trust, receiving special education, vocational training, full-time rehabilitation services, and so on. The Republic Day celebrations were followed by a flag-hoisting and special performances by Hope's special needs children, such as instrumental play, dance performances, and a fancy dress competition. Aside from this, sports were also conducted for the community, and the sports winners, both men and women, received prizes and applause. It was a wonderful day filled with joy and entertainment. In the afternoon, an eye screening camp was organized by M.N. Eye Hospital, Thiruvottiyur, Chennai. Approximately 70 rural villagers received eye screenings and first-aid treatment, and 20 were referred to the hospital for free cataract surgery. All attendees received a special lunch as well.
