VOCATIONAL TRAINING

HOPE special needs children are given training in various vocational training such as Candle making, Phenol making, Handicrafts training, Areca plate making, Agarbathi making, Cup Sambarani making & Camphor making.

These skill training has benefit of improvement in co-ordination, motor skills & vocational skills.

The training is given to HOPE special children with an aim to build their self confidence & self esteem & provide adequate support in leading an independent life.



DIGITAL COMPUTER TRAINING

HOPE is giving digital computer training to intellectually disabled children with the aim of equipping them with work-ready skills and also fostering critical thinking, independence, and problem-solving.

The training program is designed to be tailored to the individual needs of the learners, allowing them to develop at their own pace. HOPE is committed to providing an inclusive and supportive learning environment for all.

To empower these children to reach their full potential, and prepare them for successful employment. HOPE also provides emotional support to these children, to help them cope with the challenges of their disability.

Digital training has been shown to improve the ability of people with intellectual disabilities (IDs) to perform some cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) tasks. Digital training has been found to be especially beneficial for those with IDs who have difficulty understanding or remembering verbal instructions.

Digital training can also provide a more personalized learning experience, which can be tailored to the individual's specific needs.



DIGITAL COMPUTER TRAINING

HOPE is giving Digital Computer training to Intellectually Disabled Children with an aim to equip them with work readiness skills and also fosters critical thinking, independence, and problem-solving.

"Music is powerful for children with special needs."

Today, through music education for our HOPE Special Needs children, they're able to come out of the closed door and feel, understand and experience life just like us normal people. Special Needs Children and the Power of Music Creativity is a powerful teaching tool, and since music is filled with creative interaction, it's the perfect teaching tool for children with special needs try specially for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and other special needs like cerebral palsy, childhood apraxia of speech (CAS), and those with learning disabilities.

Music education and exposure have also had positive impacts on children suffering from depression and other mental illnesses. Exposure to music can also establish emotional understanding in children as well as encourage responsiveness, empathy, and communication. It also promotes feelings of empowerment and connectedness that can make a huge impact in a child's life.



SPECIAL EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

The children who are suffering from the Intellectual disability needs a special education curriculum. Certain other activities like music, dance, yoga, art & craft etc. are introduced for these children so that they can understand how to work together while doing the activities. They also get physical training that includes games and sports. Their interaction skills are improved using the sign language. This entire procedure of conveying education to them relies on the aim to make these children as much autonomous as possible. Rather than offering them studious knowledge, they need to be taught everyday activities and skills.





THERAPEUTIC INTERVENTION

Therapies provided at Hope Public Charitable Trust include occupational therapy, speech therapy, cognitive behavioral therapy, art therapy, family therapy, tactile therapy, and social skills therapy.

THERAPEUTIC INTERVENTION

The therapy team first focuses on identifying and exploring each child's potential and opportunities. Then recommends and provides therapy either in groups or individually as per the needs of the child.

During the therapeutic process, therapist look beyond the child's problem or syndrome and through a personally tailored work-process, therapist strengthens and develops child's potential/skill.

First therapist will begin working with skills appropriate for the developmental stage the child didn't go through. The child re learns all the processes that he/she skipped, step by step, the absence of which has created (or reinforced) the developmental disorder. As a result, the gap between child's chronological age and developmental situation reduces significantly. Relearning that process, he/she missed and constantly practicing them encourages the brain and nervous system to improve performance skills. A good framework is set in place for the potential learning skills of the kid.

Thus, therapies help students to improve their ability to perform tasks in their daily living and working environments.

Fabric Painting Class for the students of Annambedu Village. The children were delighted to acquire new skills and extremely happy to see their own art work.




HOPE SPECIAL EDUCATORS MEETING




